The Dublin Middle Tier Soccer Organization wants YOU!!!

What is The Dublin Middle Tier Soccer Organization (DMTSO)? It is the Dublin implementation of the GOYSL (Greater Outerbelt Youth Soccer League) Program for the **U-7 to U-13 age groups for girls and boys**. There may be other leagues these teams will be eligible to participate in as well. **The DMTSO grew by over 70% last year!!!**

Who is the program designed for? The program is designed for players at the U-7 to U-13 level who have experienced success in the DSL recreation program and are looking for a stronger soccer program, but are not yet ready for the time and financial commitment of Club Soccer.

Who will the teams play? The teams will play teams from Dublin, Hilliard, Marysville, Worthington, Olentangy and Central Ohio..

Who will coach the teams? The teams will be coached by licensed parent coaches (some of the more experienced and knowledgeable coaches from the DSL recreation program).

How will teams be formed? The teams will be formed by the DMTSO.

How many games and practices will they have? Three to four “contacts” (total of games and practices) each week. They will play 10 - 12 regular season games and will participate in a tournament at the end of each season.

How much will the program cost? Under \$400 for the entire year (Fall and Spring Seasons). The DMTSO Team Camp is included for all participants.

Which Choice is best for my child? See the accompanying table for a comparison of the Club Soccer, DMTSO and the Dublin Soccer League Recreation Programs. Ultimately, each parent must decide what is best for their individual child. Please note that the information provided regarding club soccer is an example of a typical club environment. Dublin residents may elect to play club soccer in Dublin or in any surrounding community. Therefore, the table below does not actually represent any actual club, but rather illustrates the major differences between the different environments.
