

What is Dublin United Soccer Club (formerly known as DMTSO)? It was created as the Dublin implementation of the GOYSL (Greater Outerbelt Youth Soccer League) Program for the **U-7 to U-12 age groups for girls and boys**. Dublin United teams now play in the Ohio Champions League, the Mid Ohio Select Soccer League (MOSSL) and GOYSL. Dublin United is one of the largest clubs in Central Ohio.

Who is the program designed for? The program is designed for players at the U-7 to U-14 level who have experienced success in the DSL recreation program and are looking for a stronger soccer program, but are not interested or not yet ready for the time and financial commitment to Elite Club Soccer.

Who will the teams play? The teams usually play teams from Dublin, Hilliard, Marysville, Powell, Worthington, Westerville and other surrounding communities.

Who will coach the teams? The teams will be coached by licensed parent coaches (some of the more experienced and knowledgeable coaches from the DSL recreation program) with about 10 additional professional group training sessions.

How will teams be formed? The teams will be formed by Dublin United with input from the coaches.

How many games and practices will they have? Three to four “contacts” (total of games and practices) each week. They will play 10 - 12 regular season games, will participate in league tournaments and at least one more tournament.

How much will the program cost? \$425 for the entire year (Fall and Spring Seasons) including uniforms, all games, all tournaments, all fees including the professional training sessions. The fee is significantly less for players on U-7 teams. This cost also includes four day Kickoff Event-Team Camp in August.

Which Choice is best for my child? See the accompanying table for a comparison of the Club Soccer, DMTSO/Dublin United and the Dublin Soccer League Recreation Programs. Ultimately, each parent must decide what is best for their individual child. Please note that the information provided regarding club soccer is an example of a typical club environment. Dublin residents may elect to play club soccer in Dublin or in any surrounding community. Therefore, the table below does not actually represent any actual club, but rather illustrates the differences between the different environments.
